THE SOLEMN BEGINNING OF THE VIGIL

THE BLESSING OF THE FIRE and PREPARATION OF THE PASCHAL CANDLE

A fire is prepared. The Priest greets the assembly and blesses the fire.

Priest: Dear brothers and sisters, . . . Through Christ our Lord.

Response: Amen.

The paschal candle is prepared. The Priest lights the candle from the new fire, saying:

May the light of Christ rising in glory
dispel the darkness of our hearts and minds.

*The Deacon accepts the paschal candle from the Priest and a procession is formed.
The Deacon lifts the candle high and sings:*



As the procession continues all candles are lit from the paschal candle. When the procession reaches the middle of the church the Deacon lifts the candle high and sings a second time:

Deacon: The light of Christ.

Response: Thanks be to God.

When the procession arrives before the altar, the Deacon faces the people and sings a third time:

Deacon: The light of Christ.

Response: Thanks be to God.

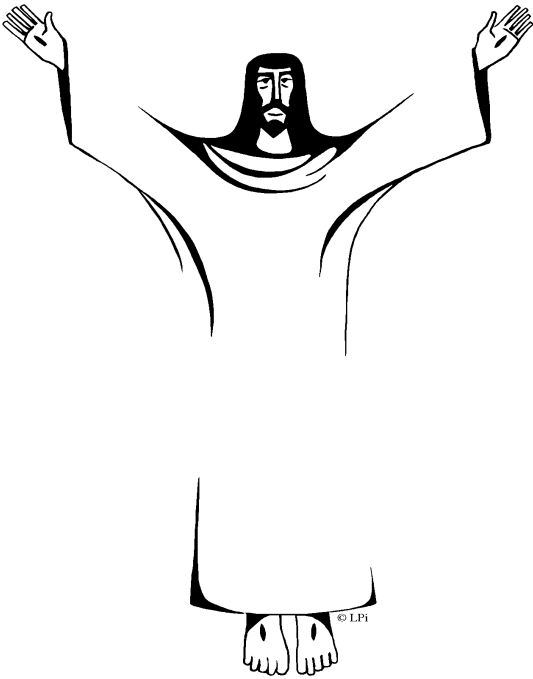
Jesus Christ Is Risen Today
