Response: And with your spirit.


PENITENTIAL RITE







TRANSFER OF THE EUCHARIST

Following the prayer after Communion, all kneel as the priest incenses the Blessed Sacrament on the altar. The Blessed Sacrament is then carried down the center aisle of the Church to the main doors, out to West Street and into the hall to the altar of reposition. As the Church does not celebrate Mass on Good Friday, the Eucharist is reserved so that Communion can be received at the celebration of the Passion of the Lord. The chapel will remain open for private prayer and meditation until 10:00PM.
